## Section I. Statement of Authority.

This Local Law is authorized by the New York State Constitution, the provisions of the New York Municipal Home Rule Law, the provisions of the Statute of Local Governments, the relevant provisions of the Town Law of the State of New York, the laws of the Town of Yorktown and the general police power vested with the Town of Yorktown to promote the health, safety and welfare of all residents and property owners in the Town.

Section II. Chapter 275-17 (D)(1) through (6) of the Code of the Town of Yorktown entitled "SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES:SCHOOL ZONES" are amended to read as follows:

### (D) School Zones.

(1) Intent. It is the intent of this subsection to provide improved compliance with the speeding limitations at or near entrances to schools within the Town.

(2) The Town hereby designates school zones at the schools listed in Section D(3) below. The school zones shall be in effect on school days between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m, unless otherwise stated. Unless otherwise posted, the speed limit in such school zones is established at 15 miles per hour for a distance of 300 feet in either direction from the building line of the schools. Any violation of the posted speed limit within the times indicated will result in a doubling of the otherwise applicable fine.

- (3) The following areas are designated as school zones:
- (a) Brookside Elementary School on Broad Street;
  - (b) Mohansic Elementary School on Locksley Road;
  - (c) Crompond Elementary School on Manor Street and on Saddle Ridge Road;
  - (d) French Hill on Baldwin Road;
  - (e) Veterans Road from the intersection of Maple Hill Street to 250 feet west of the Yorktown Community Nursery School. The zone should be in effect school days between 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.
  - (f) Thomas Jefferson School on Gomer Street;
  - (g) Lakeland High School on East Main Street;
  - (h) St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Elementary School on East Main Street;
  - (i) George Washington Elementary School on Lexington Avenue.

Section III. **Chapter 275-17 (E) (3) (a) through (h) of the Code of the Town of Yorktown entitled "SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES: PARK ZONES" is amended to add new subsections 275-17 (E) (3) (i) through (m) to read as follows:**

- (i) Sparkle Lake Park:
- (1) "Entering Park Zone" sign on the northbound side of Granite Springs Road at the intersection of Broad Street.
  - (2) "Leaving Park Zone" sign on the southbound side of Granite Springs Road at the intersection of Broad Street.
  - (3) "Entering Park Zone" sign on the southbound side of Granite Springs Road at the northmost intersection of Sarles Drive.
  - (4) "Leaving Park Zone" sign on the northbound side of Granite Springs Road at the northmost intersection of Sarles Drive.

(j) Fox Den Park:

- (1) "Entering Park Zone" sign on the eastbound side of Jacob Road at the intersection of Catherine Street.
- (2) "Leaving Park Zone" sign on the westbound side of Jacob Road at the intersection of Catherine Street.
- (3) "Entering Park Zone" sign on the westbound side of Jacob Road at the intersection of Jordan Drive.
- (4) "Leaving Park Zone" sign on the eastbound side of Jacob Road at the intersection of Jordan Drive.

(k) Chelsea Park:

- (1) "Entering Park Zone" sign on the southbound side of Gomer Street at the intersection of Sterling Terrace.
- (2) "Leaving Park Zone" sign on the northbound side of Gomer Street at the intersection of Sterling Terrace.
- (3) "Entering Park Zone" sign on the northbound side of Gomer Street, 300 feet south of the south park boundary.
- (4) "Leaving Park Zone" sign on the southbound side of Gomer Street, 300 feet south of the south park boundary.

(l) Hunterbrook Park

- (1) "Entering Park Zone" sign on the southbound side of Mill Pond Road at the intersection of Old Crompond Road.
- (2) "Leaving Park Zone" sign on the northbound side of Mill Pond Road at the intersection of Old Crompond Road.
- (3) "Entering Park Zone" sign on the southbound side of Bound Brook Lane at the intersection of Old Crompond Road.
- (4) "Leaving Park Zone" sign on the northbound side of Bound Brook Lane at the intersection of Old Crompond Road.
- (5) "Entering Park Zone" sign on the southbound side of Hunterbrook Road at the intersection of Old Crompond Road.
- (6) "Leaving Park Zone" sign on the northbound side of Hunterbrook Road at the intersection of Old Crompond Road.

- (7) "Entering Park Zone" sign on the northbound side of Hunterbrook Road at the intersection of Jacob Road.
  - (8) "Leaving Park Zone" sign on the southbound side of Hunterbrook Road at the intersection of Jacob Road.
- (m) Catherine Street Field
- (1) "Entering Park Zone" sign on the southbound side of Catherine Street at the intersection of Old Crompond Road.
  - (2) "Leaving Park Zone" sign on the northbound side of Catherine Street at the intersection of Old Crompond Road.
  - (3) "Entering Park Zone" sign on the northbound side of Catherine Street at the intersection of Jacob Road.
  - (4) "Leaving Park Zone" sign on the southbound side of Catherine Street at the intersection of Jacob Road.

#### Section IV. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, phrase, paragraph or any part of this local law shall for any reason be adjudicated finally by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation and effect to the clause, sentence, phrase, paragraph or part thereof, directly involved in the controversy or action in which such judgment shall have been rendered. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that the remainder of this local law would have been adopted had any such provisions been excluded.

#### Section V. Repeal

All ordinances, local laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

#### Section VI. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall become effective upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law.


