We are Here for You During COVID-19: The Women's Resource Center continues to be fully operational despite our physical offices being closed. Our staff continue to be available by phone and email 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday, as well as other times by appointment. Remote services include crisis intervention, therapy, case management and victim advocacy. In-person services continue with the emergency domestic violence shelter remaining open, fully staffed and operational, with all COVID-19 precautions in place. In addition, victim advocacy services are available in person in an emergency. All services can be accessed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week via the hotline number 845-628-2166.
