WASTES WE ACCEPT

- Paint (both oil and latex)
- Automotive fluids, except motor oil
- Wood preservatives, stains and polish
- Pesticides, insecticides, and herbicides
- 🍄 Kerosene, turpentine, and other flammable liquids
- Photo and swimming pool chemicals
- 🗳 Fluorescent light bulbs, CFLs tube-shaped bulbs
- Fire Extinguishers
- Propane tanks up to 20 lbs. in size
- Mercury thermometers and thermostats
- Electronic waste, e.g. computers, TVs, radios
- Freon-containing household appliances, e.g. air conditioners, refrigerators, and dehumidifiers
- 🗳 Scrap metal
- 🚳 Car tires with or without rims, up to four
- Vehicle and rechargeable batteries
- Expired, unused prescription and over-the-counter medications in original containers
- Papers for secure shredding: remove all bindings, clips, and bring in boxes or paper bags
- Textiles (in plastic bags): clothing, footwear, accessories, linens

Bring your documents for secure shredding!



SAFETY RULES

- Place all items in your trunk or backseat
- Stay in your vehicle at all times
- Drive slowly
- Follow signs & employee instructions
- Only bring accepted wastes

WASTES WE DO NOT ACCEPT

- S Motor oil: return to a service station or other retailer
- Smoke & fire detectors: dispose of as trash
- O Compressed gas, helium, and oxygen tanks
- S Explosives, fireworks, ammunition, flares
- ♦ Cell phones
- Single-use Alkaline batteries: place in trash
- **O** Plastic bags: return to a grocery stores
- Needles, syringes, and lancets: return to a medical provider or hospital, or place in an empty laundry detergent bottle, securely tape the lid and dispose of in trash
- ♦ Non-Residential wastes
- Oconstruction debris
- Vard waste: let leaves breakdown in your yard, or contact your municipality about our Organic Yard Waste Program!
- South States See if your municipality has a Food Scrap Program or visit CompostED to learn to compost in your own backyard!
