Dear Taxpayers,

Due to public health and safety concerns, the Town of Yorktown Tax Office is closed to the Public until further notice. In accordance with the Real Property tax law of NYS, your taxes are still due April 30, 2020. Local officials do not have the authority to change the date or waive penalties. If there are any changes granted by state officials, we will notify the public. For your convenience the Tax Office offers the following payment options:

- Online via electronic check. You provide your check routing and account number and the funds are transferred to the Town free of charge. http://www.yorktownny.org/online-payments
- Credit card payments are also accepted on online. Please note there is a 3% fee, dictated by a third party vender who processes the payment. This is <u>not</u> a town fee. http://www.yorktownny.org/online-payments
- There is a drop box in front of town hall for all town business.
- Payments by mail. If you are mailing a tax payment, please make sure there is a timely official **United States Post Office postmark** affixed to the envelope no later than the due date. Postage meter (i.e.-Pitney Bowes) and foreign postmarks are not acceptable. When an envelope contains payment of local taxes with no U.S. postmark date, the payment of such taxes is deemed to have been made on the date the payment is received. RPTL s922.
