From the Supervisor's Office

Be It Resolved that, at the request of The American Cancer Society, the Town Board hereby authorizes the use of Room 104 at the Yorktown Community & Cultural Center on Friday May 4th, 2018 from 7am to 10am and 11:45am to 4pm for activities related to the "Paint the Town Purple" event and Room 26 and the gymnasium at the Yorktown Community & Cultural Center beginning at 5pm on Friday, June 8th 2018 through 1am on Saturday, June 9th, 2018 for activities related to the "Relay for Life" event. The Town Board waives the rental fees of \$611.00.

<u>Authorize support of Senate Bill S7358 and Assembly Bill A5979 that would mandate</u> that the state pay all local property taxes for state owned land in Westchester County, including the Town of Yorktown

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Town Board to do all it can to lessen the tax burden of Yorktown property owners, and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Town Board that New York State pays local property taxes on state-owned land in most counties in New York State, including neighboring Putnam and Rockland counties, but with the exception of Westchester County, and

WHEREAS, New York State is not paying any local property taxes on approximately 1,000 acres it owns in Yorktown, including approximately 600 acres in FDR State Park, and 154 acres in the French Hill Section of Donald J. Trump State Park, and

WHEREAS, New York State pays town, county, school and fire taxes on approximately 300 acres it owns in the Indian Hill section of the Donald J. Trump Park in Putnam County, and

WHEREAS, New York State owns approximately 2,300 acres in the Town of Cortlandt, including 1,900 acres at Camp Smith which is in the Lakeland School district, and

WHEREAS, Senator Terrence Murphy has sponsored Senate Bill S7358 that would mandate that the state pay all local property taxes for state-owned land in Westchester County, including the Town of Yorktown,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town board send a letter to our State Senator, Terrence Murphy, showing support for the passage of S7358, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Board send a letter to our State Assemblyman, Kevin Byrne, showing support for the companion bill sponsored by Assemblyman David Buchwald, A5979 in the Assembly.

<u>Approve extension of bid for Laboratory Services for the Water Pollution Control Plant</u> WHEREAS:

- 1. The Town Board at its meeting of May 3, 2016, awarded the bid for Laboratory Services for the Water Pollution Control Plant, Bid #16-1, to EnviroTest Laboratories, Inc.
- 2. The contract documents included options to extend the bid for two (2) additional 1-year terms. The Town has received satisfactory service from EnviroTest Laboratories and would like to continue to utilize their services.
- 3. Both the Town Engineer and Asst. Plant Superintendent recommend the Town exercise its option to extend the agreement for laboratory services for one (1) additional year the final available extension as per the contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board extends the agreement with EnviroTest Laboratories, Inc. for Laboratory Services at the Water Pollution Control Plant Bid #16-1, for an additional one year period, under the same terms and conditions. Contract Price: \$11,140.00 (see attached) Contract term: 5/3/2018 until 5/3/2019.
