Authorize amendment to Bid Award for Pump Station Upgrade Program

Whereas, the Town Board passed a resolution on May 22, 2018 awarding the bid for the Pump Station Upgrade Program: Walden Woods and Jefferson Valley Pump Stations, which excluded the reconstruction of the Jefferson Park Pump Station, and

Whereas, the Town Board wants to now include the Schedule E. Additive Alternatives: the reconstruction of the Jefferson Park Pump Station: General Construction in the amount of \$445,000 and Electrical Construction in the amount of \$41,974, now

Therefore Be It Resolved, the inclusion of this work will not change the lowest bidders for the General Construction: Kings Capital in the amount of \$1,995,000, and Acorn Electrical for the Electrical Construction in the amount of \$350,000 for a total bid amount of \$2,345,000.

Be It Further Resolved, the contract is to commence upon the Town's issuance of a Notice of Award and the contract completion date shall be 365 calendar days from the Notice of Award date.

Authorize the creation of the Pump Station Rehabilitation Project

Resolved, that the Town Board authorizes the creation of the Pump Station Rehabilitation Project with an authorized spending in the amount of \$2,345,000 for contracts awarded to Kings Capital Construction, Inc (\$1,995,000) and Acorn Electrical Contracting (\$350,000)

Be It Further Resolved, the Comptroller is authorized to transfer \$2,345,000 from the Sewer Fund – Fund Balance to fund this project.

Whereas, Genesee Valley Ford LLC has submitted the lowest bid for the Ford Utility Police Interceptors; and

Whereas, the State of New York Office of General Services has awarded Mini-Bid Response #18020052, Award 22898, Contract #PC67357 to the lowest bidder; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Yorktown hereby authorizes the Yorktown Police Department to transfer \$18,000 from the General Fund – Fund Balance to the Police Department Vehicle Line (A3120.210) for the purchase of one (1) Ford Utility Police Interceptor (to replace a previously damaged police vehicle) from the State of New York Office of General Services, Award 22898, Contract #67357 from Genesee Valley Ford LLC in the amount of approximately twenty eight thousand, nine hundred and ninety dollars and no cents (\$28,990.00).
