#### From the Supervisor's Office

#### **Re-establish the Environmental Panel**

WHEREAS, the Town of Yorktown Town of Yorktown established a panel of staff members known as the Environmental Panel, which had as its purpose meeting with the public to streamline environmental permits and disseminating other development related information to aid permittees in navigating the permit process; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Panel ceased its operations in 2016, and

WHEREAS, the town board of the Town of Yorktown desires to re-establish the panel to provide the public with assistance in the permit processes of the Town; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Town board re-establishes the Environmental panel and that it shall consist of the Town Engineer, the Town Building Inspector and the Director of Planning, and other staff or volunteer board members that may be appropriate to the duties of the panel; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the panel shall be chaired by the Director of Planning and shall meet on a regular basis as is necessary to execute its duties and provide assistance to potential permittees in the permitting processes of the Town.

## Authorize SPARC, Inc. use of rooms at the Albert A. Capellini Community and Cultural Center at a reduced rate

Be It Resolved, that the Town Board authorizes SPARC Inc., use of rooms at the Albert A Capellini Community & Cultural Center, to provide social and recreational programming to teens and young adults with developmental disabilities, the Town Board hereby reduces the room rent fees from \$4,851.00 to \$420.00 for 183 hours of room use beginning on October 12, 2018 through March 29, 2019 as indicated in the schedule below.

#### Authorize the American Red Cross use of rooms at the Albert A. Capellini Community and Cultural Center for a blood drive

Be It Resolved, that the Town Board authorizes the American Red Cross use of rooms at the Albert A Capellini Community and Cultural Center, to hold a blood drive.

#### **Mobile Community Stage Policy**

Whereas, the Town of Yorktown is barred from providing organizations with a gift of public funds, now

Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Mobile Community Stage will be under the direction of the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation, and

Be It Further Resolved, the fee for the use of the Mobile Community Stage will be \$1,000 and the transportation fee will be \$300.

#### From the Building and Maintenance Department

#### Authorize Supervisor to sign an agreement with US Communities under a Master Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement

RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor is authorized to enter into an agreement with US Communities under the Master Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement (MICPA) with Cobb County, GA and US Communities for roofing with contract holder Garland/DBS. Inc. and authorizing the Town of Yorktown to make purchases for the benefit of the Town of Yorktown through US Communities, Garland/DBS. Inc. There is no charge to the Town for joining this purchasing system.

#### From the Engineering Department

#### Authorize funding for Bridge Replacement – Hill Boulevard over Barger Brook

WHEREAS, a project for the Replacement of Hill Boulevard over Tributary to Barger Brook (BIN 2265539) in the Town of Yorktown, Westchester County, PIN. 8761.66 (the Project") is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs such program to be borne at the ratio of 95% Federal funds and 5% non-federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Yorktown will design, let and construct the Project: and

WHEREAS, the Town of Yorktown desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the costs of the work for the Project or portions thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yorktown Town Board, duly convened does hereby

RESOLVE, that the Yorktown Town Board hereby approves the above-subject Project; and it is hereby further

RESOLVED, that the Yorktown Town Board hereby authorizes the Town of Yorktown to pay 100% of the cost of right-of-way acquisition work for the Project or portions thereof, with the understanding that qualified costs may be eligible for federal-aid, state-aid, or reimbursement from Bridge NY funds; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the sum of \$16,104 (calculated as follows: Original Budget, \$5,000 plus \$11,104 Additional Work equals New Total \$16,104) is hereby appropriated from available Town funds and made available to cover the cost of participation in the above phase(s) of the Project and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Yorktown Town Board hereby agrees that the Town of Yorktown shall be responsible for all costs of the Project which exceed the amount of federal-aid, state-aid, or NY Bridge funding awarded to the Town of Yorktown and it is further

RESOLVED, that in the event the Project costs not covered by federal-aid, state-aid, or NY Bridge funding exceed the amount appropriated above, the Town Board of Yorktown shall convene as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the Supervisor thereof; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Town of Yorktown hereby agrees that construction of the Project shall begin no later than eighteen (18) months after award and the construction phase of the Project shall be completed within thirty-six (36) months; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor of the Town of Yorktown be and is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Town of Yorktown all necessary agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for federal-aid and/or state-aid with the New York State Department of Transportation in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the Town of Yorktown's funding of Project costs and permanent funding of the local share of federal-aid and state-aid eligible Project costs and all Project costs within appropriations therefore that are not so eligible; and it is further

RESOLVED, that in addition to the Supervisor the following municipal titles: Town Attorney, Town Engineer and/or Town Comptroller are also hereby authorized to execute any necessary Agreements or certifications on behalf of the Municipality/Sponsor, with NYSDOT in connection with the advancement or approval of the project identified in the State/Local Agreement;

RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary Agreement in connection with the Project; and it is further

RESOLVED, this Resolution shall take effect immediately.

## <u>Authorizes Comptroller to accept the project Performance Bond received from Acorn</u> <u>Electric for the Pump Station Upgrade Project</u>

#### WHEREAS:

1. The Town Board awarded the Pump Station Upgrade Bid at the Town Board Meeting of April 5, 2018 to Acorn Electrical Contractors, LLC, for a total bid amount of \$350,000 for the electrical portion of the project.

2. Acorn Electrical Contractors, LLC as Applicant, provided the Town with Argonaut Insurance Company c/o CMGIA #CMGP001560, in the amount of \$350,000.

3. The documentation submitted by the Applicant was referred to the Town Attorney and Town Comptroller for review and acceptance as to form.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the delivery of the required project Performance Bond has been satisfied and that the Town Comptroller is authorized to accept the above referenced project Performance Bond.

## Authorize Comptroller to release monies totaling \$250 to Morfea - #WP-BSWPPP-049-17 Mohansic Avenue East

WHEREAS:

- 1. Luigi & Gretchen Morfea as applicants, posted check #163 in the amount of \$250 which was deposited to the T33 account on October 27, 2017, to serve as the Performance Bond for site work performed at the Mohansic Avenue East location.

## <u>Approve Extension of Bid for Various Chemicals for the Water Pollution Control</u> <u>Plant</u>

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Town Board at its meeting of October 17, 2017, awarded the bid for Various Chemicals for the Water Pollution Control Plant, for four (4) chemicals. The term of the contract was one year, expiring on November 1, 2018.
- 2. The contract language included an option to extend the bid for an additional one year term at the same price, contract terms and conditions, upon mutual consent of the Town and the contractor.
- 3. Four (4) of the vendors agreed to hold their bid price for an additional 1-year period:
  - a. Shannon Chemical Corp. for Citric Acid 50%,
  - b. Slack Chemical Co. for Sulfuric Acid not more than 51%, Sodium Bisulfite 38% and Sodium Hypochlorite 15% and
  - c. Clean Waters, Inc. for Polymer
  - d. PVS Technologies for Ferric Chloride
- 4. The Town Engineer recommends that the Town accept the bid extension for an additional 1-year term, for the period of 11/1/18 through 10/31/19.
- 5. There are two (2) chemicals in which the vendor did not wish to extend the current Town agreement, the Town is currently advertising for bids for these chemicals.

RESOLVED, that the Town Board extends the contract with the above referenced chemical companies, for Various Chemicals for the Water Pollution Control Plant, for a one year period, commencing on 11/1/18 and ending 10/31/19.
