NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that all residents of the Town be encouraged to honor Dr. King and celebrate his memory by living out his teachings.

# Establishes an annual "Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Essay Contest;"

WHEREAS, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. devoted his life to strengthening the American character and called on our nation to live up to its founding principles of life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness for all its citizens; and

WHEREAS, through his determination, spirit, and resolve, Dr. King led one of the greatest movements for equality and freedom in history; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Yorktown wishes to honor the legacy of this great American and remember the ideals for which he fought; and WHEREAS, as we observe Dr. King's birthday, the Town encourages all its residents to celebrate his memory by performing acts of kindness through service to others;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town hereby establishes the annual "Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Essay Contest;" and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Town residents in the 4th and 5th grades shall be entitled to participate; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Supervisor shall be responsible for coordinating the logistics surrounding the Contest, including soliciting submissions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board shall review the submissions and select and announce the winners of the Contest.

# Authorize the hiring of four (4) "part-time available" assistant fire inspectors

WHEREAS, until such time as the Town has hired an additional Fire Inspector or an additional Assistant Building Inspector, the Building Department is desirous of hiring four (4) "part-time available" assistant fire inspectors; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that James Malone, Alexander Vergo, Paul Liberatore and John Falcone are qualified to perform the duties described above on an interim basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that until the Town has hired an additional Fire Inspector or an additional Assistant Building Inspector, the Town is authorized to hire four (4) "part-time available" assistant fire inspectors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Supervisor is authorized to prepare a request for proposals from qualified attorneys and law firms with experience in municipal law matters for the provision of the Services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Supervisor is authorized to advertise for such proposals.

RESOLVED, that Oak Ridge Hauling, LLC be and is hereby granted renewal of their Garbage License to service commercial properties in the Town of Yorktown for the year 2020.

# Approve Order Calling the Public Hearing for the Establishment of Hallocks Mill Sewer District Extension

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Yorktown, Westchester County, New York, has received a petition, together with a map showing the boundaries of a proposed sewer district extension in said Town, to be known as Hallocks Mill Sewer

District Extension in the Town of Yorktown (the "Extension") a general plan to serve said Extension, and a report of the proposed method of operation thereof; and

WHEREAS, said map, plan and report were prepared by a competent engineer duly licensed by the State of New York, and have been filed in the office of the Town Clerk of said Town, where the same are available during regular office hours for examination by any persons interested in the subject matter thereof, including estimate of cost; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of said Extension shall be as described in Exhibit A, As described in the list of parcels attached hereto and hereby incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the improvements proposed consist of the construction of a sanitary sewer system at a maximum estimated cost of \$14,300,000; and

WHEREAS, the cost of hook-up fees to the typical property in said Extension is \$5,850 (gravity connection) and \$15,100 (pumped system); and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of said Extension to the typical property therein is \$1,494 in the first year in which operation, maintenance, debt service and other charges and expenses are to be paid (\$782 for a typical property not connected); and

WHEREAS, a detailed explanation of the manner by which such costs were computed has been filed in the office of the Town Clerk where the same are available during regular office hours for examination by any person interested in the subject manner thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to call a public hearing upon the question of the establishment of said Extension and the improvements proposed therefor, all pursuant to Section 193 of the Town Law; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

ORDERED, by the Town Board of the Town of Yorktown, Westchester County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. A meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Yorktown, Westchester County, New York, shall be held at the Town Hall, 363 Underhill Avenue, in Yorktown Heights, New York, in said Town, on the 18th day of February, 2020, at 7:30 o'clock P.M., Prevailing Time, for the purpose of holding a public hearing to consider the establishment of the Sewer District Extension in said Town as described in the preambles hereof, to be known as Hallocks Mill Sewer District Extension, and the improvements proposed therefor, and to consider the petition, map, plan and report filed in relation thereto, and to hear all persons interested in the subject matter thereof concerning the same, and for such other action on the part of said Town Board as may be required by law or shall be proper in the premises.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause a copy of this order to be published once in <u>The Yorktown News</u>, the official newspaper of said Town, the first publication thereof to be not less than ten nor more than twenty days before the day set herein for the hearing as aforesaid, and said Town Clerk shall also cause a copy thereof to be posted on the sign-board of the Town maintained pursuant to subdivision 6 of Section 30 of the Town Law not less than ten nor more than twenty days before the day set for the hearing as aforesaid.

Section 3. This order shall take effect immediately.

### From the Town Engineer

Approve Release of Performance Bond for Bonfiglio - #BSWPPP-T-039-16 & #BSWPPP-068-16 - Baldwin Road WHEREAS:

- 1. Michael Bonfiglio as applicant for a land development project at 1233 Baldwin Road, posted check #6322 in the amount of \$2,500 to serve as the Erosion Control Bond for permit #BSWPPP-T-039-16, which was deposited to the T33 account on August 1, 2016.
- 2. Michael Bonfiglio as applicant posted check #6432 in the amount of \$1,700 \$500 of this money was posted to serve as the Performance Bond for permit #BSWPPP-068-16, which was deposited into the T33 account on December 5, 2016.
- 3. Michael Bonfiglio as applicant has requested monies be released as the project work is now complete.
- 4. The Town Engineer has informed this Board that a representative of his department has inspected the property and determined that the work has been satisfactorily completed, and that the above referenced monies may be released,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT, RESOLVED, that the above referenced monies totaling \$3,000 be and are hereby released to Sensible Choice Contracting, LLC, 1000 Saw Mill River Road – Suite B, Yonkers, NY 10710, Attn: Mr. Michael Bonfiglio.

# Approve Reduction of Performance Bond for Underhill / Kear Retail & Office Site Development - #FSWPPP-T-068-17 WHEREAS:

1. Planning Board Approval Resolution #17-20 and the Engineering Permit issued for this project required the Applicant to post a Performance Bond in the amount of \$50,000.

- 2. Kear Underhill Associates, LLC, as applicant provided the Town with check #1019 in the amount of \$50,000, which was deposited into the T33 account on September 21, 2018 to serve as the Performance Bond for permit #FSWPPP-T-068-17.
- 3. Kear Underhill Associates, LLC, has requested the Performance Bond be released.
- 4. The Engineering Department has inspected the property and determined that the improvements for the site have been completed. The project completion date has been established as 10/31/19.
- 5. Since the Engineering Permit requires a \$5,000 maintenance bond for a period extending one (1) year past the project completion date, the Engineering Department recommends reducing the Performance Bond to \$5,000 (\$50,000 less \$45,000). In lieu of this, the Applicant may post a \$5,000 Warranty/Maintenance Bond and the Performance Bond may be returned in full.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Performance Bond is hereby reduced to \$5,000 (\$50,000 - \$5,000 = \$45,000 back to developer) and may be released to Kear Underhill Associates, LLC, 10 Julia Lane, Suite 101, Cold Spring, NY 10516. The remaining funds (\$5,000) will be held until the 1-year warranty/maintenance period has elapsed.

WHEREAS, as confirmed by the Town Comptroller, monies have been allocated in the 2020 Water Department budget line SW.8340.0201.0002 (equipment/vehicles) for these purchases; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board authorizes the Yorktown Water Department to purchase a John Deere 310SL HL Backhoe Loader pursuant to the New York State Contract for Heavy Equipment from John Deere Shared Services, Inc. DBA John Deere Construction Retail Sales and one model RB100G Hydraulic Hammer for the Backhoe Loader from RBHAMMERS Corp. for a total cost of \$120,073.87.
