## From the Town Supervisor

## Oppose the imposition of a toll on I-684

WHEREAS, as a part of its state-wide toll plan, the state of Connecticut is considering installing a toll on I-684 in Connecticut;

WHEREAS, the state of New York absorbs the overwhelming financial burden for I-684; and

WHEREAS, the proposed toll will encourage drivers to divert to local roads and create an incredible disruption to the quality of life in many Westchester municipalities by increased traffic, and unnecessary financial burden through further wear and tear.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Town opposes the imposition of a toll on I-684.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board authorizes the Town
Supervisor to sign a Permit Application that will authorize RC Recreation
Development LLC to submit associated application documents to the New York State
Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) and other appropriate
regulatory authorities as required for the Golf Course and Clubhouse Development
Project, located at 795 Route 6.

## Approval of Sign at The Winery at St. George

WHEREAS, an application for permission to erect a sign on property located at 1715 East Main Street, Mohegan Lake, NY 10547 owned by Old St. Georges, LLC and presently improved by a structure operating as a restaurant under a site plan approved pursuant to section 300-167 et. seq. has been made before the Town Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 300-167 et. seq. the Town Board is the sole approving authority and may approve and/or condition the plan of development of the property and the uses thereon as in its discretion it deems appropriate; and

WHEREAS, Old St. Georges, LLC's application was heard at a duly noticed public work session on January 14, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board referred the application of Old St. Georges, LLC to the Advisory Board on Architecture & Community Appearance (ABACA) which has issued a memorandum dated January 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, ABACA suggested that the applicant consider larger decorative posts with flush or raised panels, for the sign to be illuminated with ground mounted sign lighting and for landscaping to be incorporated at its base. And therewith ABACA has no objection to permitting the sign as requested subject to a final review of the final color scheme proposed prior to releasing a sign permit; and

WHEREAS, ABACA has expressed its approval of the application and encourages the owner to consider installing a sign which would complement the unique nature of the establishment and structure; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has submitted herewith and the Town Board has considered the following: a "Short Environmental Assessment Form" evidencing no identified impacts as a result of the proposed action, a site plan depicting the proposed location of the sign including its setback from the front property line and a rendition of the sign by McCaffrey Signs, Inc.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, the Town Board declares itself to be the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) and finds that the proposed action is an unlisted action with no identifiable impacts and therefore issues herewith a negative declaration; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board approves the location of the sign as shown on the site plan submitted herewith and approves the sign as shown on the McCaffrey Sign's Inc. depiction as submitted by the applicant providing ABACA with the final proposed colors and design including treatment of the sign posts and therewith working with ABACA to a final approved design. The Board hereby approves the location, size and general characteristics and design of the sign subject to the foregoing.

## **Emergency Repair of Steam Pipe in AACCC Gymnasium Floor**

Whereas, on Friday, January 31, 2020 a steam pipe under the gymnasium floor at the AACCCC burst, causing major damage to the floor, heating issues in the gym, and an emergency situation necessitating the canceling of classes and programs that are held in the gymnasium.

Whereas, based on an estimate provided by Peak Performance, Inc., the funds required to make the necessary emergency repairs for the steam pipe are estimated to be \$6,885.00, and be it hereby

Resolved, the Town Comptroller is authorized to make available the amount of \$6,885.00 to make the necessary emergency repairs to the steam pipe at the AACCC, and the Town is authorized to contract with Peak Performance, Inc., in an amount of \$6,885.00 to repair the steam pipe.

Appointment of Richard Romanski to the Parks and Recreation Commission WHEREAS, the authority to make appointments is vested in the appointing power in office when the vacancy arises;

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2019, this Board adopted a resolution by a 3-1 vote to reappoint Ms. Diana L. Quast to the Recreation Commission for a term beginning on January 1, 2020 and expiring on December 31, 2026;

WHEREAS, former Supervisor Gilbert's vote was the deciding vote to pass the resolution;

WHEREAS, former Supervisor Gilbert's term of office ended on December 31, 2019;

WHEREAS, because Ms. Quast's previous term on the Recreation Commission expired on December 31, 2019, the vacancy arose on January 1, 2020;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board finds Ms. Quast's December 17, 2019 reappointment to be invalid;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Richard Romanski is hereby appointed to the Recreation Commission for the term expiring on December 31, 2026.
