3. **PROCLAMATION**

Recognize and Proclaim Police Week in the Town of Yorktown WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Town Board to recognize and proclaim May 10-

16, 2020, as Police Week in the Town of Yorktown in conjunction with the State of New York as well as National Police Week; and

WHEREAS, this observance is to honor the service and sacrifice of those law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty while protecting our communities and safeguarding our democracy; and

WHEREAS, National Police Week was first established by Congress and recognized by President John F. Kennedy in 1962 to pay special recognition to those law enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty for the safety and protection of others; and

WHEREAS, since the first recorded death in 1791, more than 21,000 law enforcement officers in the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice and been killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the names of these dedicated public servants are engraved on the walls of the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, D.C.; and

WHEREAS, members of the Yorktown Police Department have participated in the Police Unity Tour, traveling 300 miles by bike to raise funds to maintain the national memorial; and

WHEREAS, it is the sense of the Town Board to commend the long-standing efforts of law enforcement in the State of New York which diligently contributes to the efficient operation of our criminal justice system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board pause in its deliberations to proclaim May 10-16, 2020, as Police Week in the Town of Yorktown; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Yorktown Town Board pause in its deliberations to remember the more than 21,000 members of the law enforcement community who have lost their lives in the line of duty.

<u>Convene Public Hearing to consider Teatown Lake Reservation's request for</u> <u>a General Maintenance Permit for the restoration of a portion of the wetland</u> <u>and repair to the Teatown Lake Dam on the property located at 1600 Spring</u> <u>Valley Road</u>

Supervisor Matt Slater will convene a public hearing via video conferencing to consider the application received from Teatown Lake Reservation for a General Maintenance Permit – Wetlands/Stormwater/Tree for the restoration of a portion of a wetland located at the Teatown Lake Reservation, 1600 Spring Valley Road, Ossining, New York, also known as Section 69.14, Block 1, Lot 5 on the Tax Map of the Town of Yorktown. The request is to perform the following activity: restoration of a portion of the wetland below the Visitor's Center by removing approximately 600 cubic yards of sediment and installation of a sediment catchment basin, installation of a construction access and planting of the area of sediment removal with native shrubs, trees, and herbaceous plants and maintenance and repairs to the Teatown Lake Dam.

<u>Convene Public Hearing to consider the request of Tracy Chalifoux, LLC on</u> <u>behalf of property owner Ann Hess for a Wetland/SWPPP Permits to dredge</u> <u>a pond on the property located at 1390 Old Logging Road</u>

Supervisor Matt Slater will convene a public hearing via video conferencing to consider the application received from Tracy Chalifoux, LLC on behalf of the property owner Ann Hess to consider the Wetland/SWPPP Application for the dredging of a pond located at 1390 Old Logging Road, also known as Section 47, Block 17, Lot 1-31 on the Tax Map of the Town of Yorktown. The request is to perform the following activity: suction dredging of a 0.21-acre pond of approximately 520 cubic yards of wet sediment, which will be dried and transported off site; the existing driveway will be used for machinery access; and all disturbed areas will be restored.
