SPECTRA ENERGY/ALGONQUIN GAS TRANSMISSION

REQUEST FOR TRANSITIONAL ZONING CONSIDERATION FROM WILLIAM PRIMAVERA - HICKORY STREET

Mr. Dan Ciarcia, engineer for applicant, and Mr. Bill Primavera were present to discuss with the Town Board their request to rezone his property on Hickory Street. Mr. Primavera stated that his PR business has grown and he would like to be able to rezone his property which is surrounded by commercial establishments to Country Commercial or Transitional, this will allow him to better utilize his home for his business which he is currently allowed to do.

Supervisor Grace stated that a Transitional Zone would preserve this house better then Country Commercial. The house is historic and he does not want someone to be able to just demolish it.

Councilman Bernard stated that Mr. Primavera should begin by putting in a formal petition to rezone his property along with the appropriate plans and fees to the Town Clerk. The Town Board would then review the request and decide whether it wants to move the rezoning forward or not based on the information provided.

WATER DEPARTMENT UPDATE FROM DAVID RAMBO WATER DISTRIBUTION SUPERINTENDENT

Water Distribution Superintendent David Rambo was present to discuss with the Town Board several water projects to be completed during the year. He updated the Town Board on cement lining projects on Front Street, Strawberry Road and Baldwin Road. He stated that this would be a 1.6 million dollar project and approximately \$80,000.00 would be for Engineering Services. Mr. Rambo requested to place a backhoe which is several years old on Auctions International, Inc. to sell to the highest bidder.

Supervisor Grace stated that this is the backhoe that the Parks Department was interested in purchasing from the Water Department. Mr. Rambo stated that it is.

Supervisor Grace stated that he has no problem putting it out to auction to see what kind of price it gets. After the bids come back the Town Board will review them before it is sold.

Mr. Rambo requested to hire a part-time cleaner for the Water Department Building. Supervisor Grace stated that Water Department staff can clean the building. Additional staff is not needed.

Water Distribution Superintendent Rambo stated that he would like to go out to bid on the roof replacement for the Water Department's brick building and for Water Maintenance Materials. The Town Board agreed to place this on the next agenda.
