WHEREAS, the observance of National Hispanic Heritage Month celebrates the histories, cultures, and contributions of American citizens whose ancestors came from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean and Central and South America; and

WHEREAS, the observation started in 1968 as Hispanic Heritage Week under President Lyndon Johnson and was expanded by President Ronald Reagan in 1988 to cover a 30-day period starting on September 15 and ending on October 15; and

WHEREAS, the day of September 15 is significant because it is the anniversary of independence for Latin American countries Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras and Nicaragua; and

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Yorktown recognizes and celebrates National Hispanic Heritage Month.

10. PUBLIC HEARING

Decision: Proposed Local Law amending Chapter 300-52 to add Boutique Hotels Adopt Negative Declaration for Local Law amending Chapter 300-52 to add "Boutique Hotels"

WHEREAS, the Town Board is considering an amendment to Chapter 300, entitled "Zoning" by amending Article VII, Section 300-52 to add "Boutique Hotel" ("Action"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Board, being the sole approval authority, is lead agency by operation of law; and

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2022, Town Clerk duly transmitted the proposed local law and Full EAF dated June 9, 2022 to all Interested Agencies; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT:

- 1. The Town Board hereby assumes Lead Agency status in connection with the SEQRA review of the Action.
- 2. That the Town of Yorktown shall adopt in its determination of significance this NEGATIVE DECLARATION, indicating that information provided in the Environmental Assessment Form has sufficiently demonstrated that the proposed action will not result in significant adverse environmental impacts.

Adopt Local Law amending Chapter 300, entitled "Zoning" by amending Article VII, Section 300-52 to add "Boutique Hotel"

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Yorktown has undertaken to adopt a new local law relating to amending Chapter 300, entitled "Zoning" by amending

Article VII, Section 300-52 to add "Boutique Hotel"; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board, being the sole approval authority, is lead agency by operation of law; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of a new local law relating to amending Chapter 300, entitled "Zoning" by amending Article VII, Section 300-52 to add "Boutique Hotel" is a Type I action under SEQRA; and

WHEREAS, the proposed local law was referred to and reviewed by the Advisory Board on Architecture and Community Appearance, Building Inspector, Conservation Board, Engineering Department, Yorktown Heights Fire Company Engine #1, Highway Department, Planning Department, Police Department, Public Safety Committee, Yorktown Central School District, Tree Conservation Advisory Commission, Water Department and Zoning Board of Appeals of the Town of Yorktown; and by the Westchester County Planning Board/Department, Westchester County Department of Health, Westchester County Environmental Facilities, Westchester County Soil and Water; and by the New York State Department of Conservation, Albany & Region III, New York State Department of Transportation, New York State Army Corps of Engineers; and the New York City Department of Environmental Protection; and the Town of Cortlandt, Town of Ossining, Town of Putnam Valley; Town of Somers; and

WHEREAS, modifications to the proposed local law have been made to incorporate the comments and recommendations of the reviewing boards and departments; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board convened a Public Hearing with respect to the proposed local law on August 3, 2022, which was adjourned and reconvened and closed on September 6, 2022; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the satisfaction of the Town Board that adoption of this proposed local law will have no significant adverse impacts; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the proposed local law shall be adopted by roll call vote of the Town Board of the Town of Yorktown.

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Distribution Superintendent to have the Quinlan water storage tanks #1 and #2 inspected and repair a minor leak in tank #2; and

WHEREAS, a proposal was received from CorrTech Inc. to conduct remote operated vehicle (ROV) inspection service of the two tanks, repair the leak in tank #2 and provide a condition assessment report for each for a total project cost of \$7,650; and

WHEREAS, the Water District has monies in line SW.8320.0416 to cover such inspections; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board authorizes the Supervisor to sign an agreement with CorrTech Inc. to conduct inspection service of the Quinlan water storage tanks for a cost of \$7,650.
