#### **Resolution Recognizing October as Hindu Heritage Month**

WHEREAS, in celebration of Diwali, the Town of Yorktown is partnering with HSS Shakas as part of a countywide Sewa Diwali initiative to collect food for local shelters and food pantries; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Yorktown recognizes October as Hindu Heritage Month; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Yorktown extends its best wishes to all in our community celebrating Diwali; and

BE IT FURTHE RESOLVED, that the Town of Yorktown continues it mission of being a community of acceptance for all who call Yorktown home.

# Authorize Barton & Loguidice to complete a watershed inventory for the Towns planned local waterfront revitalization plan

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Yorktown desires to complete a Watershed Inventory for an area to be included in the Town's planned Local Waterfront Revitalization Plan with scope of work as outlined in Section 1 of the proposal titled, "Town of Yorktown Watershed Inventory and Analysis," prepared by Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C., and dated September 23, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C., an environmental consulting firm, has entered into an agreement with the Town of Yorktown to provide these services on an on-call basis which was authorized by the Town Board by resolution on July 7, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C. has submitted a proposal to provide the requested service for an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Supervisor of the Town of Yorktown is hereby authorized to engage Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C. under the on-call agreement with the Town of Yorktown for the purpose of completing a Watershed Inventory, in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00, and that \$15,000.00 will be reimbursed by Hudson River Valley Greenway Grant and \$15,000.00 is the Town's required match.

#### Accept the retirement of Joseph Lewis from the Water Department effective October 28<sup>th</sup> 2022

RESOLVED, that the Town Board accepts the retirement letter received from Joseph Lewis from the Water Department with many thanks for his 35 years of service to the Town, effective October 28, 2022.

WHEREAS, the applicant has requested his money be released as the site is now complete, and

WHEREAS, the Town Engineer has informed this Board that a representative of his department has inspected the property and determined that the work has been satisfactorily completed, and that the above referenced monies may be released,
