## **COMPTROLLER**

## Authorize \$6,750 change order to contract with Carbon Enterprise Inc

Whereas, the Town previously awarded a bid to Carbon Enterprises, Inc (Carbon) for the purchase and delivery of 216 tons of filter sand. Carbon misunderstood the bid document and was planning on delivering the sand with palletized bags of sand. They agreed to hold their bid and deliver the sand with the specialized trucks required to place the sand within the filters. The delivery process quickly degrades the hoses used to deliver the sand. Carbon agreed to provide 60 feet of hose; however, additional hose would either have to be purchased by the Town or provided at an additional charge to place the sand inside of the building. The Town attempted to purchase 80 feet of hose, but only 40 feet shipped. We were unable to locate an alternative source for the hose and ultimately decided paying Carbon additional money to supply the hose was the best value.

Carbon bid the project at \$53,185,68. The next lowest bidder was GP Jager, Inc at \$83,560. Carbon has agreed to provide the additional hose for \$6,750. I am requesting the Town Board adopt the following resolutions to facilitate the delivery of sand to the Yorktown Heights Water Pollution Control Plant:

Resolved, that Comptroller is authorized to transfer \$3,500 from YS fund balance to Maintenance and Repair (YS.8130.0460), and

Be it further resolved, that the Comptroller is authorized to transfer \$3,500 from YS fund balance to Maintenance and Repair DEP (YS.8130.0460.003), and

Be it further resolved, that Change Order #1 for the Sand Filter Media for the Yorktown Heights Water Pollution Control Facility project in the amount of \$6,750 is hereby approved.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor is hereby authorized to sign an Agreement, subject to prior review and approval by the Town Attorney, between the Town of Yorktown and Empire Consulting for services in compliance with the Federal Department of Transportation regulations regarding drug and alcohol testing services in accordance with the fee schedule attached to the Agreement. The Agreement shall be effective from October 2023 until October 2028, subject to renewal at the Town's option

**Town Board in conjunction with the Highway Superintendent consent to road dedication** WHEREAS, on July 17, 2023, by Resolution #23-11, the Town of Yorktown Planning Board resolved to approve an Amended Site Plan and a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan and a Tree Permit for the construction and operation of a Walgreens store at the property owned by J. Nazzaro Partnership L.P. located at 3320 Crompond Road, Yorktown Heights, also known as Section 26.18, Block 1, Lots 23, 25 & 26 on the Town of Yorktown Tax Map (the "Property");

WHEREAS, the approved Walgreens project includes an offer of dedication by the property owner to the Town of Yorktown of an approximately 802 square-foot strip of land on the Property along the Stony Street property boundary for the widening of Stony Street as shown on the drawing titled "Lot Line Adjustment Plat" prepared for J. Nazzaro Partnership, L.P. prepared by Badey & Watson Surveying & Engineering D.P.C. dated November 14, 2022 and detailed in the metes and bounds "Description of Property" dated February 6, 2023;

WHEREAS, the widening of Stony Street as well as improvements to Stony Street and Old Crompond Road are part of the approved Walgreens project and will serve to improve traffic and road service in the area;

WHEREAS, recognizing the benefits to the community of the Stony Street and Old Crompond Road improvements as well as the approved Walgreens project, the Town Board consents to the offer of dedication of property;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board, in conjunction with the Highway Superintendent, consents to the offer by J. Nazzaro Partnership L.P. of dedication to the Town of Yorktown of an approximately 802 square-foot strip of land on the Property as

shown in the Lot Line Adjustment Plat and detailed in the Description of Property for the purpose of widening Stony Street.

# Accept decommissioning Bond for energy storage system

WHEREAS, Yorktown Energy Storage 1, LLC, as applicant, provided the Town with Federal Insurance Company's Bond No. K41764429 in the amount of \$252,471, to serve as the decommissioning bond for an electric energy storage system at the premises located at 3901 Gomer Court (Tax Map 6.1 7-1-24) in the Town of Yorktown, as approved by a Town Board Resolution dated October 4, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the documentation submitted by the Applicant was referred to the Town Attorney for review and acceptance as to form;

NOW, THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that, subject to the receipt and approval of the Town Attorney, the bond required prior to issuance of the Town permits, i.e. delivery of the required project decommissioning bond has been satisfied and that the Town Comptroller is authorized to accept the above referenced project bond.

BE IT FURTHER RESOVED, that pursuant to NY Town law §82 and 90, within ten (10) days from the date of this Resolution the Town Clerk shall post and publish an notice a notice which shall set forth the date of the adoption of the Resolution, shall contain an abstract of such Resolution concisely setting forth the purpose and effect thereof, shall specify that this Resolution was adopted subject to a permissive referendum; and shall publish such notice in The Yorktown News, a newspaper published in the County having a general circulation in the Town of Yorktown, and in addition thereto that the Town Clerk shall post or cause to be posted on the sign-board of the Town of Yorktown, a copy of such notice within ten (10) days after the date of the adoption of this Resolution.
