- Thursday, October 30: 12 p.m. – 8 p.m.
- Friday, October 31: 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.
- Saturday, October 31: 12 p.m. – 5 p.m.
- Sunday, November 1: 12 p.m. – 5 p.m.
