Re: Asphalt Laid In Place Bid

A representative of Montesano Brothers, Inc. has sent a letter to my office requesting answers to ten questions. The answers were supplied by David Paganelli, the Yorktown Highway Superintendent.

1) Does the bid require a bid bond?

Answer: No Bid Bond is required.

2) Will the successful bidders be required to supply the Town with a Performance Bond and a Labor and Material Payment Bond?

Answer: No Performance, Labor and Materials Bonds required.

3) How many Tons does the Town plan to install this year?

Answer: Tonnage this season depends on cost. We plan to spend \$600,000 minimum and \$690,000 maximum.

4) Is there a list of streets that the town is planning to pave this year?

Answer: Tentative list of streets available is attached.

5) Just to confirm, the town provides all traffic control?

Answer: Town provides all traffic control.

6) What are the project work hours?

Answer: Project work hours are 7:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

7) Does the project get completed in one mobilization to the town, or is the work completed in phases that will require a mobilization-demobilization and remobilization to the town?

Answer: We try to achieve paving with one mobilization to town but cannot rule out multiple mobilizations. Town is 39 square miles and paving done in many areas.

8) Does the Town adjust all manholes, catch basins, drainage inlets and utility structures to proposed finished grade prior to paving?


Answer: Town does adjust all manholes, catch basins, etc. to finish grade as paving

9) Does the town sweep the pavement prior to tack coat application and resurfacing?

Answer: Town does sweep prior to paving.

10) In the Contract Documents, Page 14, Paragraph 7. The asphalt price adjustment base posted price shows a posting date of June 1, 2014, is this date correct or will June 2015 be used as the AC base posted price?

Answer: June 1, 2014 AC base posted price.
